KING ROLAND tends to go well fresh and gets the vote to make a winning debut over fences. He hasn't done a great deal wrong in his short racing career to date, ending last season with a placed effort in Grade 2 company over hurdles, and might improve for having had wind surgery and for the application of a tongue-tie. Cheddleton also ran well in a Grade 2 hurdle when last sighted and he merits close consideration representing an in-form Jennie Candlish stable, while Getaway Fred and Gumball add further spice to a cracking race.

Can You Call was outclassed in the Champion Bumper at Cheltenham, but had shown ability behind the fourth in that contest, Third Time Lucki, when fourth on debut at Market Rasen and is feared along with Landen Calling and Cousu Main.
