The form of that contest took a boost when Galvin (second) scored at Prestbury Park last week and the race has a history of being a good source of future winners. I K Brunel lost little in defeat when narrowly denied at Fontwell and the move up in distance could play to his strengths, while Snow Leopardess was a respectable third in a trappy contest at Bangor and is well worth her place in this line-up.
